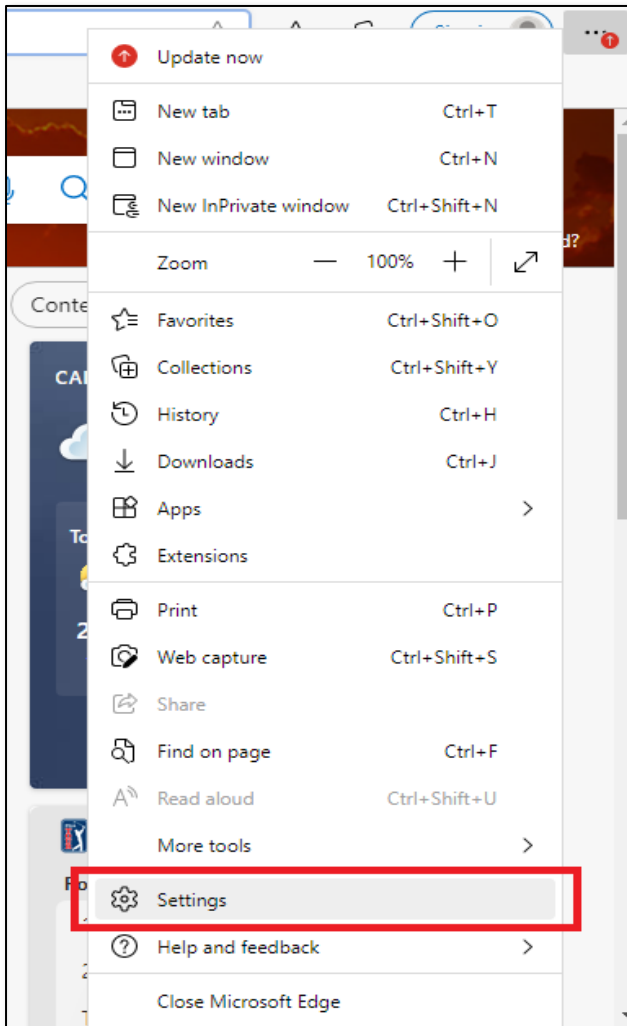
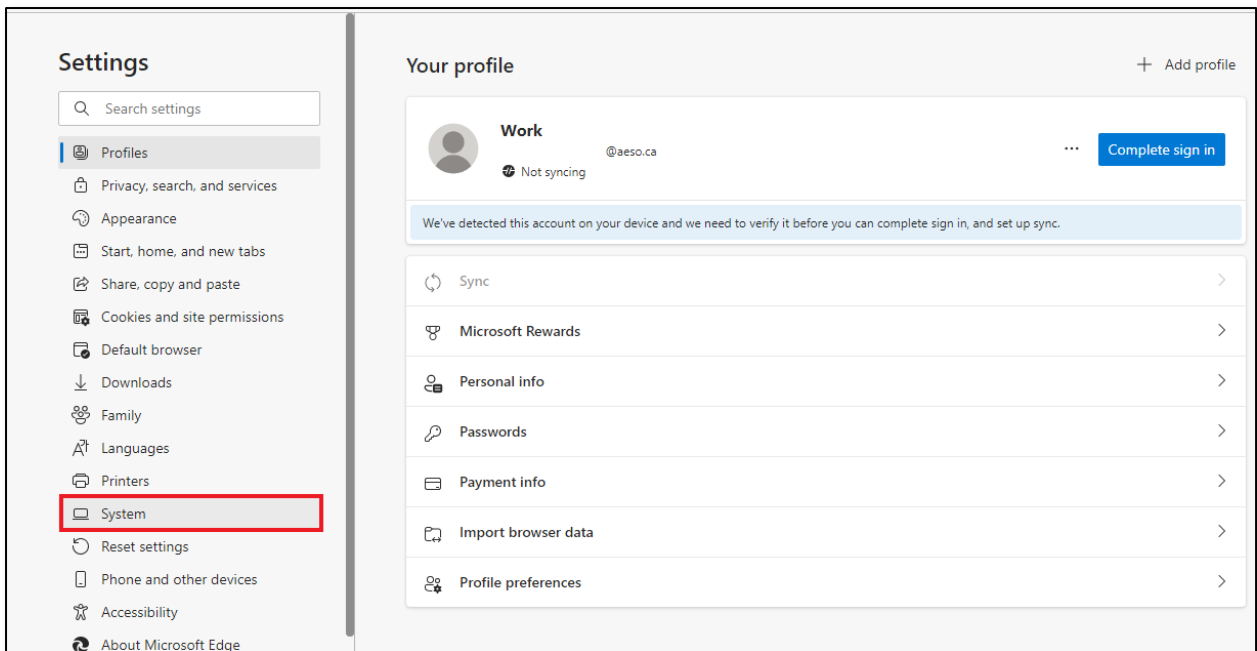


Follow the steps below to configure Microsoft Edge for optimal performance for use with the AESO's Automated Dispatch and Message System (ADaMS).

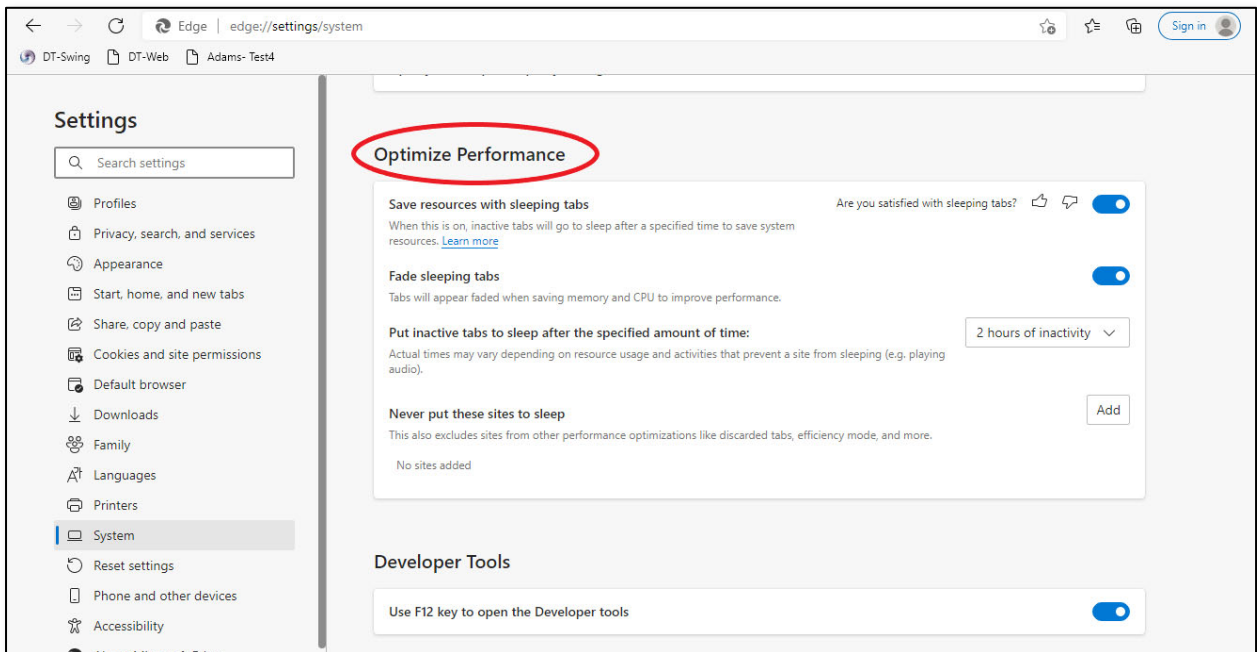
1. Open Microsoft EDGE browser.
2. Click on (. . .) on top right of the browser and open **Settings**.



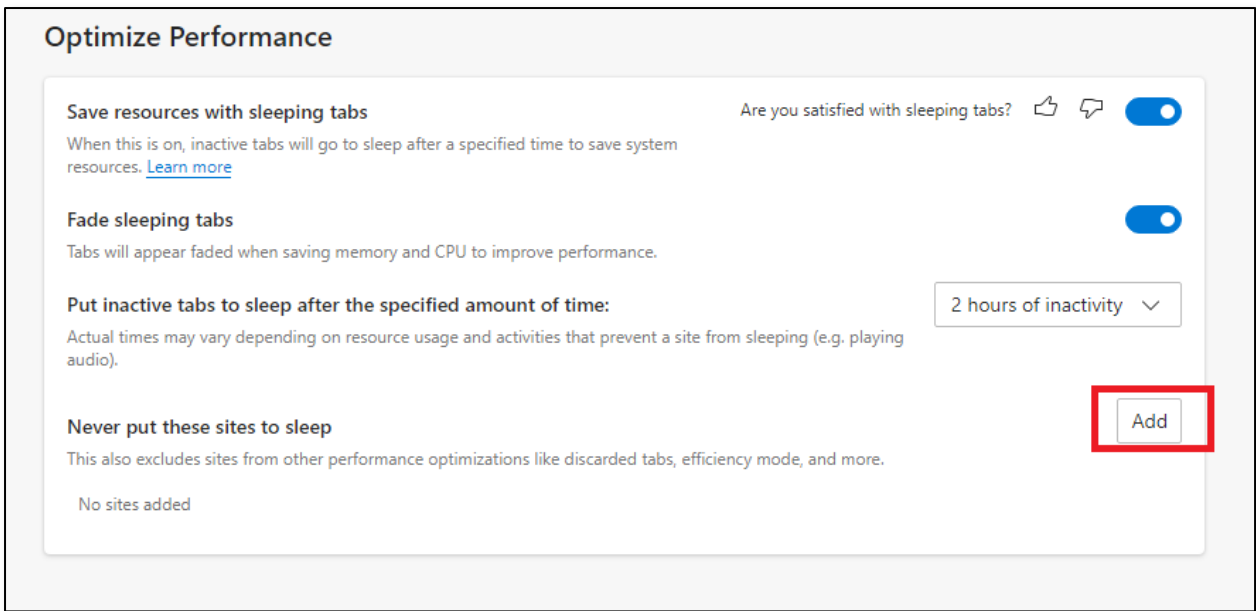
3. On the Settings page, click on **System**.



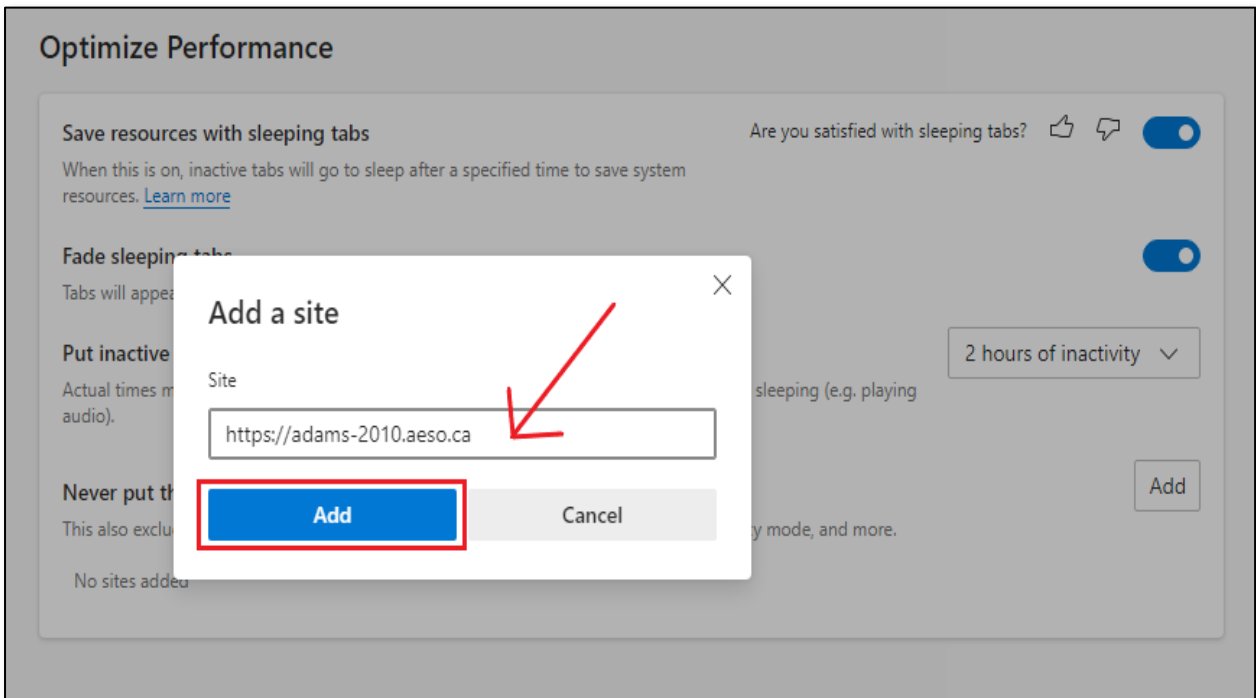
4. Under System Settings, go to the **Optimize Performance** section.



5. Under Optimize Performance section, click on the **Add** button.



6. By clicking on the Add button, a **Dialog Box** will open as shown below.
7. In the **Site** field, enter the URL: <https://adams-2010.aeso.ca> and then click the **Add** button.



8. Verify the URL is successfully added as shown below.

Tabs will appear faded when saving memory and CPU to improve performance.
