Needs identification document approval cancellation

Cancellation application requirement (CT1)

Provide the approval number to be cancelled and the rationale for the cancellation.

The AESO is applying to cancel Needs Identification Document (NID) Approval 23429-D02-2019 (issued April 10, 2019) for the Provost to Edgerton and Nilrem to Vermillion (PENV) Transmission System Reinforcement, including the following system developments:

- (a) One new Drury 2007S Substation;
- (b) One new 240-kV single-circuit transmission line from the existing Nilrem 574S Substation to the Drury 2007S Substation;
- (c) One new 240-kV single-circuit transmission line from the existing Hansman Lake 650S Substation to the Killarney Lake 267S Substation T-tap point (749AL);
- (d) Relocating the connection of the 749AL T-tap from Transmission Line 749L to the new line described in (c);
- (e) One new 240-kV single-circuit transmission line from the existing Edgerton 899S Substation to the Killarney Lake 267S Substation T-tap point (749AL); and
- (f) Connection of the existing Transmission Line 7L65 in an in-and-out configuration to the Drury 2007S Substation; renaming of the segment of Transmission Line 7L65 between the Drury 2007S and Vermilion 710S substations as Transmission Line 7L205.

The AESO has determined that PENV is no longer needed due to changes in system topology, load forecasts, and the energization of the Central East Transfer Out (CETO) project.

This application satisfies the direction included in Decision 30228-D01-2025, "to file an application either amending or cancelling the Provost-to-Edgerton portion of the PENV NID before the end of 2026" and is consistent with the AESO's December 10, 2025 Annual Milestone Update to satisfy Directions 23429-D02-2019-0006 and 0008.

adjacent to, the project right-of-way or location.
