Navigant’s findings and report on the Bulk and Regional tariff proposed rate alternatives</li> </ol> <p>Once these materials are made public, we then request adequate time to develop Bulk and Regional tariff proposed rate alternatives. The October 22, 2020 session should be postponed in order for transmission customers to be able to provide meaningful proposals.</p>
