Re: **Reactive Power from Generating Units**

Further to our [January 26, 2006 letter](#), the AESO has completed its analysis of generator compliance with AESO reactive power requirements. We have accordingly commenced one-on-one discussions with the affected parties.

Generator owners and those parties with interests in generating units have received, or will shortly receive, a letter outlining our plan to ensure compliance with the reactive power requirements. These letters outline the requirements for each generator and where appropriate, they consider the PPA committed capacity and reactive power requirements.

The AESO reactive power requirements are specified by the Interconnection Requirements ([website link](#)) which are a condition of System Access Service under the AESO Tariff and are consistent with industry (i.e. NERC/WECC) standards.
