

Project Cancellation for the Halkirk 2 Wind Power Project Connection

The Capital Power L.P. (Capital Power) request for transmission system access to connect its proposed Halkirk 2 Wind Power Project (Facility) in the Tinchebray area in the County of Paintearth has been cancelled.

BACKGROUND

In May 2017, ATCO Electric Ltd. began distributing an information package that included the AESO's Need Overview, Halkirk 2 Wind Power Project Connection. The AESO Need Overview included the following transmission developments:

- Modify the existing Tinchebray 972S substation, including adding a 240 kilovolt (kV) circuit breaker.
- Add a 240 kV transmission line to connect the Facility to the Tinchebray 972S substation.
- Add or modify associated equipment as required for the above transmission developments.

NEXT STEPS

The AESO no longer intends to apply to the Commission for approval of the above developments.
