

Cancellation of the Wild Rose 1 Wind Power Project Connection in the Dunmore area

The Wild Rose 1 Wind LP request for system access service to connect the Wild Rose 1 Wind Power Project in the Dunmore area has been cancelled.

BACKGROUND

The AESO received approval from the Alberta Utilities Commission for the facilities required to connect the Wild Rose 1 Wind Power Project in August 2015. The AESO now intends to apply to the Alberta Utilities Commission to cancel the approval for following transmission developments:

- One 240 kilovolt (kV) transmission line, designated as 978L, between the Wildrose 1 Wind Power Project and the approved Elkwater 264S substation
- Modifying the approved Elkwater 264S substation, including adding three 240 kV circuit breakers
- Upgrading the existing Bowmanton 244S substation, including adding one 240 kV 45 MVar shunt reactor and one 240 kV circuit breaker.
- Adding or modifying associated equipment as required for the above transmission developments.
