

Cancellation of the Currant Lake 896S Substation in the Hanna area

The ATCO Electric Ltd. request for transmission system access to serve an industrial load in the Hanna area has been cancelled.

BACKGROUND

The Alberta Utilities Commission (Commission) originally approved the AESO's *Currant Lake 896S Substation and Transmission Line Needs Identification Document* (NID) on September 12, 2011. The NID approval included the following transmission developments:

- Add the proposed Currant Lake 896S substation, including one 144/6.9 kilovolt (kV) transformer and one 144 kV circuit breaker.
- Add one 144 kV transmission line to connect the Currant Lake 896S substation to the existing 144 kV transmission line 7L110 in a T-tap configuration.
- Add or modify associated equipment as required for the above transmission developments.

NEXT STEPS

The AESO intends to apply to the Commission for cancellation of the NID approval in late 2021.
